Dogs may be scratched due to bitches being in season, illness, injury, or death. The Hunt Committee reserves the right to require veterinarian's certificates. Requests for refunds, stating the reason for scratching, must be submitted to the Hunt Secretary by postal mail or email within seven (7) days after the conclusion of the hunt. No refunds for no-shows. Refunds will be in the amount of the registration fee less a \$15.00 administrative fee.
