- **Maximum number of dogs per flight:** Started 50, Seasoned 30, Finished 30
- **Maximum number of dogs per handler:** 12
- Each dog may only enter one stake per licensed hunt (each day of the test is a separate licensed hunt)
- A Junior Handler may run a dog that is also being run by an adult in a higher stake; however, the dog will not accrue points in the lower stake.
